



SUZUME NO GAKKO PARENT AGREEMENT

I hereby agree to allow my child/children, listed below, to participate in the SUZUME NO GAKKO PARENT PARTICIPATION SUMMER SCHOOL PROGRAM, to be held at the Wesley United Methodist Church, **July 3-21, 2017, 8:45 A.M.-12:00 NOON.**

I will:

- 1) serve on a Primary Committee and complete the required assignments as requested by the Committee Chairperson or designee;
- 2) participate on a Secondary Committee; and
- 3) work at Suzume no Gakko one day as a Floater (per family) and one day in the Classroom per child enrolled in Suzume no Gakko (2 Work Days for one child, 3 Work Days for two children, and so forth), and complete all tasks listed on Work Day cards.

I:

- 1) understand the Parent Participation Responsibilities, agree to meet them, and am willing to stand by this commitment;
- 2) have read the Family Orientation Handbook (http://suzumenogakko.org/2016_FINAL_SNG_Handbook_2016-08-10.pdf) and agree to abide by the requirements listed therein, and understand that signing this form represents a commitment to participate and cooperate in the required support of the program;
- 3) understand that failure to meet these requirements may necessitate the expulsion of my child/children's enrollment in the Suzume no Gakko Parent Participation Summer School Program and further, the revocation of pre-enrollment privileges;
- 4) acknowledge that I am not to delegate these responsibilities to individuals who are not Suzume no Gakko members or to a parent/guardian who has not signed this form¹ without prior approval from the Board of Directors;
- 5) understand and agree that my child/children is/are not covered by medical insurance under Suzume no Gakko; and
- 6) acknowledge that if I accept the grade level above or below my child's intended grade level, I may not repeat nor return to the grade level missed.
