Supervision of Others: The Student Intern will assist in supervising the students of SNG, as directed by the Senpai Sensei, SNG Staff, SNG Curriculum Directors, SNG Program Director, and SNG Board of Directors.

Major Duties

- Maintain an effective learning environment that fosters creativity, a positive self-image, positive citizenship, and a sense of community.
- Implement appropriate learning experiences as directed.

Qualifications

- Preferably a former student of SNG who is entering at least the 7th grade in the Fall.
- Must have knowledge of Japanese-American culture and heritage.
- Must demonstrate an adequate level of maturity and ethical behavior.
- Must be able to work independently.
- Must have good standing in the community.
- First-time applicants must provide at least one Letter of Recommendation from a non-family member.
- Must be able to attend the entire SNG Summer Session, unless prior permission is obtained from the Senpai Sensei.
- Additional qualifications for this position may be determined at the discretion of the Senpai Sensei.
